EBSCOhost Class – For nursing, medical and general information

EBSCOhost offers the CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature) database and other nursing, health business, consumer health, and alternative health article databases. In addition, there are databases with articles on various subjects, including many helpful to younger students.

MD Consult Class – For medical information

Search online medical books, articles, clinics, patient education handouts, drug information, images and news. You can also search the MEDLINE database through MD Consult.

Ovid Class – For medical and nursing information

Ovid provides access to MEDLINE and several Evidence Based Medicine databases. MEDLINE is a database offered by the [U.S. National Library of Medicine](http://www.nlm.nih.gov) that includes over 20 million citations for biomedical articles dating back to the 1940s, and even some to the 1800s, and also includes a subset of nursing journals.
