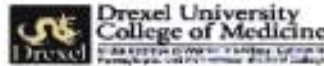



SPUH is committed to assessing the quality of the educational programs on a regular basis.


