Nationwide clinical trials at Saint Peter's University Hospital continue to work toward enhancing patient care at Saint Peter's Breast Center by contributing to a body of research that creates innovations in breast cancer treatment.

Ongoing clinical trials at Saint Peter's include the third phase of a trial that is evaluating the role of weight loss intervention and health education in the treatment of early breast cancer. Another is a pilot study examining the effectiveness of using the CyberKnife[®] Radiosurgery System for postmenopausal women who are being treated for Stage I breast cancer characterized by smaller, non-lymph node positive breast cancers.

"The pilot study is trying to determine whether using a robotic radiation delivery tool known as CyberKnife is a better option than the existing balloon technique often used for localized radiation," says Susan McManus, MD, surgeon and director, Saint Peter's Breast Center. "The latter requires twice daily treatment for five days, rather than one treatment for five days with CyberKnife."

Dr. McManus also serves as chief of Saint Peter's Breast Surgery Division and is president of Saint Peter's Physician Associates, a network of primary and specialty care physicians. A fellow of the American College of Surgeons, Dr. McManus is a member of the American Society of Breast Surgeons, the American Society of Breast Diseases, the Society of Surgical Oncology, and the American College of Surgeons.

Dr. McManus leads an interdisciplinary team that includes Lisa Hopkins, MD, breast surgeon, and Kim Dixon, MD, internist specializing in breast health, that carries out the hallmark of care at the Saint Peter's Breast Center – diagnosing breast disease – benign and cancerous – and designing individualized treatment for patients. Participating in clinical trials provides the research and knowledge that is needed to advance care.

Saint Peter's University Hospital has been named as one of America's Best Breast Centers by the Women's Choice Award[®], America's trusted referral source for the best in health care.

A clinical study known as the Tomosynthesis Mammographic Imaging Screening Trial (TMIST) is comparing the use of traditional 2-D mammography with the newest tomosynthesis or 3-D mammography in the screening of breast cancer disease. "This randomized trial not only looks at which method is better, but is also trying to discover if 3D mammography can recognize more deadly cancers," says Dr. McManus.

The multidisciplinary approach is unique to Saint Peter's. Weekly conferences with representatives from all disciplines on the healthcare team provide a comprehensive review of new cases. The team includes all physicians and clinical staff specialists involved in the unique care of patients with breast disease. Evaluation, according to the National Comprehensive Cancer Network guidelines, ensures that each case is given a thorough assessment resulting in a patient-appropriate treatment plan.

Saint Peter's Cancer Program, which includes the work of the Breast Center, is accredited by the Commission on Cancer as an Academic Comprehensive Cancer Program.
