The Craniofacial and Neurosurgical Center Designated as a fully approved "Cross-Specialty Team" by the American Cleft Palate-Craniofacial Association

Founded in 1959, the Craniofacial and Neurosurgical Center at The Children's Hospital at Saint Peter's University Hospital is one of only a few centers in the country that comprehensively treats craniofacial abnormalities, such as cleft lip and cleft palate. The Center provides specialized surgical expertise, much-needed medical knowledge, technology and compassionate support to families who have children with clefting or other craniofacial differences.

The new designation means the hospital meets the highest national standards for comprehensive care as established by the American Cleft Palate-Craniofacial Association (ACPA).

Cleft lip, cleft palate and skull-based deformities are birth defects. These occur when a baby's lip, mouth and skull do not form normally during pregnancy. As a result, these children have problems feeding and speaking. They may also experience ear infections, hearing problems or issues involving their teeth. Cleft lip and cleft palate are the most common birth defects affecting children in the United States – one of every 600 newborns is affected by cleft lip and/or cleft palate.

Because the treatment of facial differences is so complex, surgical correction alone is not sufficient to ensure the overall physical and emotional well-being of children born with these facial differences. As a result, the Center uses a team approach consisting of specialists from across multiple practice areas at Saint Peter's including:

- Audiologist
- Geneticist
- Ophthalmologist
- Oral/maxillofacial surgeon
- Orthodontist
- Otolaryngologist (ear, nose and throat)
- Pediatric dentist
- Pediatric neurosurgeon
- Pediatrician
- Plastic and craniofacial surgeon
- Program coordinator
- Registered nurse
- Speech-language pathologist
- Social worker

The multi-disciplinary team meets face-to-face to strategically prepare a personalized treatment plan for each child. Official team recommendations are recorded in the child's permanent health record and maintained electronically. They are then sent to the parents, the child's pediatrician and other integral healthcare providers.

A report on children with special needs, issued in 1987 by the Surgeon General of the United States, stressed that the care of these children should be comprehensive, coordinated, culturally sensitive, specific to the needs of the children and readily accessible. In addition, the Maternal and Child Health Bureau recognized that children with clefts and/or other craniofacial differences have special needs, and in 1991 provided funding to the ACPA to develop standards for their health care. This led to the establishment of ACPA voluntary oversight for such programs.

"A multi-disciplinary team approach yields results that are far superior to those achieved by an isolated specialist," said Bipin Patel, MD, FAAP, chairman, Department of Pediatrics, and the medical director of the Craniofacial and Neurosurgical Center at The Children's Hospital at Saint Peter's University Hospital. "A testament to our successful outcomes can be seen in the number of cases that come to us from across New Jersey and Pennsylvania. Our team is proud to have a history of developing long-lasting, personal relationships with patients and their families, a critical element of support that is needed to ensure continuity of care and a sense of confidence and positivity in the end result."

As a result of its ACPA designation, the Craniofacial and Neurosurgical Center at The Children's Hospital at Saint Peter's University Hospital is listed on www.cleftline.org for a period of five years as of January 1, 2020.


