The CARES Surgicenter, part of Saint Peter's Healthcare System, has been named "Best Ambulatory Surgery Center" in New Jersey by *Newsweek* magazine. The Best Ambulatory Surgery Centers 2022 highlights the nation's top ambulatory surgery centers based on quality of care, performance data, and peer recommendations relative to in-state competition. Ambulatory surgery centers (ASCs) have become an important part of American medicine and offer patients the ability to have specific surgical procedures performed on an outpatient basis, meaning they usually don't require hospitalization. The benefits of ASCs are that they allow patients to return home quickly, often the same day, while also reducing medical costs to patients, as well as hospitals and healthcare systems.

"Saint Peter's CARES Surgicenter has long set the standard for ambulatory surgery centers in the region and we are humbled to now be recognized as one of the nation's best and tops in New Jersey," said Kevin Nini, MD, surgeon and chairman of the CARES Surgicenter board. "On a daily basis, our physicians and staff strive to meet the highest standards in patient safety, comfort and overall experience and this recognition is proof that they not only meet but exceed industry standards."

According to *Newsweek*, the goal of its rankings is to assist readers in making informed decisions when seeking care for themselves and their loved ones. This year's list of top ASCs spotlights 470 facilities in the 25 states with the most ambulatory surgery centers. Saint Peter's CARES Surgicenter received the number one ranking when evaluated in comparison to 27 other ASCs in New Jersey. Working with data research firm Statista, *Newsweek* analyzed individual centers' performance data. As part of the research, they conducted a survey of experts, asking nurses, therapists, physicians and surgeons, and administrators in ASCs for the best surgery centers in a state they were familiar with or those in



their own state. The 2022 rankings included ambulatory surgery centers operating exclusively for the purpose of providing surgical services to patients not requiring hospitalization and in which the expected duration of services would not exceed 24 hours following an admission. Expert surveys accounted for 67 percent of a facility's overall score, with 33 percent based on quality of procedural outcomes.

Participants were also invited to assess how well the ASC in question handled the challenges of the COVID-19 crisis.

We follow the guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention with strict adherence and we also implemented a robust prescreening process for all patients. Jewish Patient Services at Saint Peter's

To further strengthen its relationship with the Jewish community Saint Peter's University Hospital appointed a patient navigator to assist Jewish patients in navigating the hospital system, advocate for them, provide support and comfort, and implement initiatives to enhance the patient experience at the hospital. The patient navigator, Rena Goldsmith Klein, MPH, (right) also provides education to the hospital staff on the special needs and considerations of Jewish patients and families.

"Saint Peter's is committed to honoring the diverse needs of our patients. As the Jewish patient navigator, I provide guidance to our Jewish patients who have particular religious needs, and help support their families during a stressful time," said Klein. "At Saint Peter's we care for patients of all faiths and recognize the role faith plays in the healing process."

Saint Peter's has many amenities that cater to the Jewish community, including a recently renovated Bikur Cholim-sponsored hospitality room for Jewish patients, families and visitors. The room is stocked weekly with kosher and special food for the Sabbath, snacks, coffee, electric candle sticks, Jewish prayer books and Jewish newspapers. Saint Peter's room service offers a kosher menu for patients and kosher meals for the holidays. A manual door at the main entrance allows for ease of entry on the Sabbath and Jewish holidays.

Rabbis from Saint Peter's Pastoral Care Department help facilitate the practice of religious rituals. In addition, the hospital arranges for shofar blowing by Jewish chaplains on Rosh Hashanah. On Sukkot, Saint Peter's constructs a sukkah outside the hospital. The hospital also

arranges for mishloach manot, donated by the Raritan Valley Bikur Cholim, to be delivered to Jewish patients on Purim.

Sharon Golubchik, a mother of five from Highland Park, was a patient at Saint Peter's during Passover. The Passover seder is one of the most celebrated rituals in a Jewish home and the seder plate consists of symbolic foods. Blessings are recited throughout the meal.

"During our first experience at Saint Peter's, the Jewish Patient Services were actually really critical. We went to the hospital with nothing—our minds being very, very far from anything that we would need to bring to the hospital for Passover. We brought nothing and yet we had everything available to us," said Golubchik. "The Jewish Patient Services at Saint Peter's were beyond exceptional each time I've been to Saint Peter's. Rena has been available at a whim for anything and everything that we've needed—things within her job description and things beyond. Her unbelievable compassion and care, and her deep understanding of the needs of the Jewish community are really remarkable and I'm so grateful for that."

Provided that Rutgers University is in session, accommodations for Jewish patients' family members can be arranged at Rutgers Chabad house, which is located three blocks away from the hospital in New Brunswick.

Saint Peter's also provides information on kosher restaurants and local synagogues and organizations that can be helpful to patients' family members while their loved one is in the hospital.
