Ovid Class – For medical and nursing information

Ovid provides access to MEDLINE and several Evidence Based Medicine databases. MEDLINE is a database offered by the <u>U.S. National Library of Medicine</u> that includes over 24 million citations for biomedical articles dating back to the 1940s, and even some to the 1800s, and also includes a subset of nursing journals.
