



We start by performing a variety of non-invasive diagnostic tests to get a clearer picture of a patient's blood flow to help us determine the best course of treatment. In many cases, we can also use these same tests to detect the majority of aneurysms in the early stages, before they rupture, allowing us to avoid emergency surgery. Our goal is to use a minimally-invasive approach to all our procedures to help patients recover faster and get back on their feet in no time."
