health van has traveled thousands of miles throughout central New Jersey visiting schools, retirement communities, day care centers, homeless shelters, senior centers, public housing complexes, shopping centers, and corporations. We are staffed with advanced practice and registered nurses. We cover Middlesex and Somerset Counties-especially those areas where healthcare services may be limited.

- Blood sugar screenings
- HbA1c (average blood sugar level for the past 2-3 months)
- Blood pressure screenings
- Cholesterol screenings
- Osteoporosis screenings
- Skin cancer screenings
- Dermascan facialscreenings
- Audio screenings

- Vision screenings
- Immunizations
- Referrals for community healthcare services
- Healthcare education
- Stroke risk assessment screenings
- Follow-up healthcare services
